Training

4.1 Details of training opportunities on the unit

Placements provided for Core, Intermediate, and Higher Anaesthesia ICM training, as well as ACCS. We could also support part of advanced training in partnership with a tertiary centre. There are Trust Grade jobs available in the department and we would be happy to work with Advanced Critical Care Practitioners.

We support placements for Foundation Doctors taster weeks and medical student placements.

Exposure to practical procedures such as percutaneous tracheostomy, vascular access, bronchoscopy; thoracic ultrasound, ECHO (including FICE mentorship), and regional anaesthesia.

4.2 Details of departmental teaching

Formal teaching is linked to Wednesday afternoon sessions mixing with anaesthesia and obstetrics. Monthly M&M and bimonthly clinical governance meetings also form part of the teaching schedule. Difficult airway including management of displaced tracheostomy local Sim teaching sessions. Dedicated programme of local MDT simulation sessions commenced 2022.

4.3 Details of clinical governance meetings days and / or M & M

ICM M&M - monthly, Joint ED / ICM M&M - quarterly, Trust Wide Clinical Governance bimonthly.

4.4 Number of trainees on each tier of the rota

1st on call ICM only, carries cardiac arrest and trauma bleep. Days 08:00 – 20:00, Nights 20:00 – 08:00. 1:8 – 1:10 depending on numbers. 1st on call theatre bleep completments 1st on call ICU 2nd on call (supports ICM but 1st on for obstetrics weekday evening and all weekend). Days 08:00 – 20:00, Nights 20:00 – 08:00. 1:8 – 1:10 depending on numbers.

IMT supernumerary and does mixture of long days, short days and nights.
